



Northwest Plumbing Heating & AC Announces Expanded Furnace Repair and Plumber Services for Quad Cities

Northwest Plumbing Heating & AC has announced expanded furnace repair and installation, and plumbing services to meet increased demand during the winter months across the Quad Cities region. The company has added technical staff and extended service hours to address heating system failures as temperatures drop throughout Iowa.

The company's furnace services encompass repair and installation for high-efficiency furnaces, boiler systems, geothermal heating units, and ductless mini-split systems. Technicians utilize diagnostic equipment to identify system failures and provide repair estimates before proceeding with service. Installation services include system sizing calculations, ductwork evaluation, and efficiency rating assessments to match heating capacity with home requirements.

The expansion comes as regional data indicates a 35 percent increase in heating system service calls during

December through February. The company's enhanced winter service program includes same-day furnace diagnostics, 24-hour emergency repair response, and installation scheduling for high-efficiency heating systems. The initiative coincides with the company's Deal of the Month program, which offers seasonal pricing adjustments for heating services.

"Winter heating failures require immediate response, and we have restructured our service department to ensure Quad Cities residents have access to prompt furnace repairs," said Bill Durand, General Manager at Northwest Plumbing Heating & AC. "Our technicians are equipped to service all heating system types, from traditional furnaces to modern geothermal units, ensuring homes maintain proper temperatures during extreme weather conditions."

Alongside heating services, Northwest maintains year-round plumbing capabilities addressing water heater installations, drain cleaning, sump pump repairs, and leak detection. The plumbing division operates independently from seasonal heating demands, providing consistent service availability throughout the calendar year. Camera inspection technology enables technicians to diagnose plumbing issues without invasive procedures, reducing diagnostic time and associated costs.

The company has introduced Service Partner Agreements starting at \$99 annually, which include scheduled maintenance visits and priority service scheduling. These preventative maintenance plans cover annual system inspections and waive after-hours service fees. Data from the National Association of Home Builders indicates that regular furnace maintenance reduces emergency repair calls by 25 percent and extends equipment lifespan by an average of five years.

Northwest has partnered with GreenSky to provide financing options for furnace replacements and major repairs. The financing program addresses the financial impact of unexpected heating system failures, with application processing completed within 24 hours for qualified customers.

As part of its customer information initiative, Northwest publishes a news article series covering heating system maintenance, energy efficiency improvements, and seasonal preparation guidelines. These resources provide homeowners with technical information about furnace operation, maintenance schedules, and replacement indicators.

Northwest Plumbing Heating & AC has operated in the Quad Cities area since 1923, providing residential heating, cooling, and plumbing services. The company maintains membership in the Nexstar Network, a national organization of independent home service contractors focused on technical training and operational standards.
